In exercise of the power conferred by section 180 read with section 89 of the Electricity Act, 2003 (36 of 2003), the Governor of Himachal Pradesh is pleased to make the following rules further to amend the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of Chairperson and Members) Rules, 2006, notified vide Notification No.MPP-A(3)-2/2003 dated 30th November, 2006 and published in the Rajpatra, Himachal Pradesh on the 10th March, 2007 namely:-

Short title and commencement.

- 1. (i) These rules may be called the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of Chairperson and members Amendment Rules, 2024.
 - (ii) These rules shall be applicable w.e.f. 29.08.2017.
- 2. For rule 4 of the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of Chairperson and Members) Rules, 2006, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"4 Pay.- The Chairperson of the Commission shall be entitled to receive a fixed salary of Rs. 2,25,000/- (Two Lakh and Twenty Five Thousand only) per month as per the Central Civil Services (Revised pay) Rules, 2016, notified vide Notification

Substitution of rule 4.

No.G.S.R721(E) dated 25th July, 2016, applicable from 1st day of January, 2016, and the Member shall be entitled to draw salary equal to the salary drawn by officer of Higher Administrative Grade:

Provided that if the Chairperson of the Commission has been a Judge of the High Court, he shall receive pay as admissible to a Judge of the High Court.

Provided further that if a person appointed as the Chairperson or Member of the Commission is a person who has retired from the service of Government or any other body owned or controlled by the Government, his/her pay in the Higher Grade Pay shall be fixed as last pay drawn (in the post which he/she have held prior to joining HPERC) minus pension in accordance with provisions contained in HP Civil Services (Fixation of Pay of Reemployed Pensioners) Orders, 1988 issued by the Finance Department vide No.Fin(C)-B(7)10/84 1/12/1988. The Chairperson Member will also be entitled to draw annual increment on the pay fixed as per above order dated 01/12/1988.

- 2. For rule 4 of the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission

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(Salary, Allowances and other Conditions of Service of Chairperson and Members) Rules, 2006, the following rule shall be substituted, namely:-

"4. Pay.- The Chairperson of the Commission shall be entitled to receive a fixed salary of Rs. 2,25,000/- (Two Lakh and Twenty Five Thousand only) per month as per the Central Civil Services (Revised pay) Rules, 2016, notified vide Notification No.G.S.R721(E) dated 25th July, 2016, applicable from 1st day of January, 2016, and the Member shall be entitled to draw salary equal to the salary drawn by officer of Higher Administrative Grade:

Provided that if the Chairperson of the Commission has been a Judge of the High Court, he shall receive pay as admissible to a Judge of the High Court.

Provided further that if a person appointed as the Chairperson or Member of the Commission is a re-employed pensioner, his pay in the prescribed scale of the post in which he is re-employed shall be fixed by deducting the amount of pension i.e. pay minus pension, in

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accordance with the provisions contained in Himachal Pradesh Civil Service (Fixation of Pay of Re-employed Pensioners) Orders, 1988, issued by the Finance Department vide OM No.Fin(C)-B(7)-10/84 dated 1.12.1988."

NOTIFICATION

In exercise of the powers conferred by Clause (d) & © of sub Section (2) of Section 180 readwith sub section(2) & (3) of Section 89 of the Electricity Act, 2003, the State Government hereby makes the following rules, namely:-

- 1.Short title and commencement: (1) These rules may be called the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory Commission (salary, allowances and other conditions of service of Chairperson and Members) Rules, 2006.
- (2) They shall come into force on the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
- 2. Definitions:- (1) In these rules unless the context otherwise requires;
- (a) "Act" means the Electricity Act, 2003;
- (b) "Commission" means the Himachal Pradesh Electricity Regulatory
 Commission
- (2) Words and expression used and not defined in these rules but defined in the Electricity Act, 2003 (36 of 2003) shall have the meanings respectively assigned to them in that Act..
- 3. Oath of office and secrecy: The Chairperson and Members of the Commission shall, before entering upon his Office, subscribed to an oath of office and secrecy before the Chief Minister, Himachal Pradesh. The Oath of office and secrecy shall be administered in the following form:

Oath of Secreey

I,.....do swear in the name of God and solemnly affirm

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that I shall not directly or indirectly, communicate or reveal to any person of persons any matter which shall be brought under my consideration or shall be brought under my consideration of the tribute of the discount of the property of the prope

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Oath and affirmation of allegiance to Constitution

Pay:- The Chairperson of the Commission shall be entitled to receive a fixed basic pay of Rs. 26,000/- (Rs. Twenty six thousand) per month only plus Dearness Pay and a Member shall be entitled for basic pay plus Dearness Pay in the pay scale of Rs. 22,400-525-24,500.

Provided that if the Chairperson of the Commission has been a Judge of the High Court, he shall receive pay as admissible to a Judge of the High Court.

Provided further if a person appointed as the Chairperson or a Member of the Commission is in receipt of any pension, the pay of such person shall be reduced by an amount equal to the gross amount of pension drawn by him.

Dearness allowance and other allowances:- The Chairperson and the Member of the Commission shall be entitled to receive dearness allowance and other allowances on the basic pay at the rate admissible to a Class-I Officer of the State Government drawing an equivalent pay.

6. Leave: The Central Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 1972 shall be

Oath and affirmation of allegiance to Constitution

4. Pay: The Chairperson of the Commission shall be entitled to receive a fixed basic pay of Rs. 26,000/- (Rs. Twenty six thousand) per month only plus Dearness Pay and a Member shall be entitled for basic pay plus Dearness Pay in the pay scale of Rs. 22,400-525-24,500.

Provided that if the Chairperson of the Commission has been a Judge of the High Court, he shall receive pay as admissible to a Judge of the High Court.

Provided further if a person appointed as the Chairperson or a Member of the Commission is in receipt of any pension, the pay of such person shall be reduced by an amount equal to the gross amount of pension drawn by him.


- 5. Dearness allowance and other allowances: The Chairperson and the member of the Commission shall be entitled to receive dearness allowance and other allowances on the basic pay at the rate admissible to a class-I Officer of the State Government drawing an equivalent pay.
- 6. Leave: The Central Civil Services (Leave) Rules, 1972 shall be

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applicable to the Chairperson or the Member of the Commission.

- Leave sanctioning authority: In the case of the Chairperson of the Commission the leave sanctioning authority shall be the 'Minister-in-charge of Multi-Purposes Projects & Power Department, and in the case of the Member, the Chairperson, shall be the leave sanctioning authority.
- 8. Provident Fund: The subscription towards Provident Fund of the Chairperson and the Member shall be governed by the provisions of the Contributory Provident Fund(India) Rules, 1962 and no option to subscrible under the provisions of the General Provident Fund Rules (Central Services), 1960 shall be available. Additional pension and gratuity shall not be admissible for service rendered in the Commission.
- 9. Travelling Allowances:- (I) The Chairperson and the Member while on tour shall be entitled to the traveling allowance/ mileage allowance and daily allowance at the same rates as are applicable to a Group 'A' Officer of the State Government drawing an equivalent pay. However, tours abroad shall be subject to the prior approval of the Chief Minister through the Multi-Purposes Projects & Power Department and clearance from the the Ministry of External Affairs from political angle and from the Ministry of Home Affairs for acceptance of foreign hospitality, if any, under the provisions of the Foreugn Contribution (Regulation) Act, 1976.
- 10. Leave travel concession: The Chairperson and the Member shall be entitled to leave travel concession at the same scale and at the same rate as applicable to Class-I Officers of the State Government drawing an equivalent pay as per the instructions issued by the Finance Department from time to time:
- Accommodation: The Chairperson and the Member of the Commission shall have the option either for allotment of Government Accommodation or house rent allowance in lieu thereof, as admissible to the officer of the State Government drawing an equivalent pay.
- 12. Transport:- The Chairperson or the Member of the Commission shall be

allowed to make use of an official vehicle.



- Telephone facility:- The Chairperson and the Member of the Commission shall be eligible for telephone facilities at Office & Residence as admissible to a Class-I Officer of the State Government drawing an equivalent pay.
- Other conditions of service: Other conditions of service of the Chairperson and the Member of the Commission, with respect to which no express provision have been made in these rules, shall be such as are admissible to a Class-I officer of the State Government drawing an equivalent pay.
- 16. Interpretation:- If the question arises relating to the interpretation of any of the provisions of these rules, the Government shall decide the same and its interpretation shall be final..
